

New Heights Climbing Wall Policies

- All climbers must have a current liability form and emergency contact information on file at New Heights. If under 18 years of age, form must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.
 - Be respectful to all climbers and instructors.
 - Boulderers must have a helmet and a spotter and must never go above their spotter's shoulders.
- First-time climbers and Lead Climbers must also wear helmets.
- Climbers must wear footwear to climb - no open toes or heels.
 - Do not step on or abuse the equipment.
 - Loose chalk is not allowed.
 - Report any loose holds, damaged equipment, or injuries immediately.
 - The use of personal gear is allowed only upon approval by a lead instructor.
- Belaying and Lead Climbing - must be approved by a Lead Instructor, indicated on the climber's info. card by the Instructor's initials and the date of approval.
- All New Heights privileges may be revoked or put on probation at any time, by any Lead Instructor, at his/her discretion. (Be on your best behavior!)
