DETAILS

For many of you, Family Camp is an annual summer tradition. Lake Geneva Christian Center is the perfect place for fun, food, and fellowship. The recreational activities we have planned for you and your family are second to none.

As always, the heartbeat of camp is rooted in the services. We bring you the best speakers for children, teens, and adults so everyone has the opportunity to meet with God in remarkable ways throughout the week.

Don't wait! Housing on the campground fills up quickly. Come for a few days or stay the entire time. Mark your calendar for June 27 – July 6, 2025!

To register go to lakegenevacamp.com, click on Family Camp, then Online Booking Link. Pick dates and unit type. The GROUP CODE is fcreg2025. (Please make sure you are entering the code correctly) Registration opens online at midnight, January 1, 2025 on a first come, first served basis.

You will receive a registration number that you will need to retain to go back in to your registration. A confirmation email will be sent to you immediately after registering. If housing is not offered on the online site, it is not available. If you need to change or cancel your registration, go back in to the FireFly registration portal. Changes made by LGCC staff require a \$35 handling fee. LGCC recommends bringing a copy of the confirmation email with you at check-in. Please remember that there is a \$5 key deposit (cash or check) for each key requested when you check in at the camp. This deposit will be returned to you when you return the key(s) at check-out. Primitive Cabins do not have locks.

RESERVATION ADD ON - MEAL TICKETS

Delicious buffet style meals are served daily in the Dining Hall. Tickets may be purchased in the camp office anytime during Family Camp or with your online registration. ADULTS & YOUTH PER MEAL: \$16.00, CHILDREN 4-11: \$8.00 (\$7.50 MN AG minister/missionary kids' discount), SENIOR ADULTS (62+) and MN AG Ministers/ Missionaries: \$14.00, Age 3 & under: Free. All meals purchased in the Dining Hall are \$19 (Adults & Youth) and \$10.00 (Kids). One free meal ticket for each 10 purchased. (Must purchase 10 in the same price increment). Meal tickets will be given to you when you arrive at camp.

Snacks and additional food items are available for purchase on the grounds. Geneva Java is open daily serving specialty coffees, smoothies, snacks, etc. Late evening coffee, tea, juice, and dessert specials are offered in the Dining Hall following the evening services. No cooking is allowed in any of the camp housing units. Additionally, Alexandria's fire code does not allow food grilling on wood decks. Food grilling must be done at least 10 feet from any building.

GENERAL

NOT PERMITTED AT LGCC: Tobacco of any kind, vaping, THC products, alcohol, illegal drugs, and fireworks. Anyone bringing these items to LGCC will be asked to leave with no refund. All individuals under the age of 18 must always be under the supervision of an adult.

PET POLICY: With the exception of qualified service animals individually trained for guests with disabilities, animals or pets are not allowed at LGCC except in personally owned RV's located in the Hillcrest RV Park. Emotional support animals are not permitted.

Personal items such as bedding, towels and pillows are not provided except in hotel-style rooms.

Skateboards and bicycles may not be in any buildings or on walkways. No ATVs or motorized skateboards are allowed on the property and golf carts may only be driven by those with a valid driver's license over age 16.

INSURANCE: Secondary insurance coverage is carried by LGCC. All injuries must be reported to the camp office and first submitted to the individual camper's insurance holder. A nurse will be available on-site daily.

RV SITE INFORMATION: Campfires and pets are only allowed in the Hillcrest RV Park. Your RV must be at least 35' long to reserve a pull-thru site (LG RV Park only) and under 25' long to reserve a partial site (HC RV Park only).

TENTS: Tent sites are on a first come, first served basis in the 600 block (West) and on the North grassy area. Each tent pitched is \$26 per night with a tag required; this includes anything placed beside a cabin but does not include dining tents.
