For many of you, Family Camp is an annual summer tradition. Lake Geneva Christian Center is the perfect place for fun, food, and fellowship. The recreational activities we have planned for you and your family are second to none.

RESERVATIONS ARE ONLINE

Family Camp reservations open online at 8:30 am on Monday, Jan. 5, 2026. First-come basis. There is a 2-night minimum stay for Family Camp. The site link is on the LGCC website: www.lakegenevacamp.com. Click "Family Camp," then "Online Reservation."

Registration opens online at 8:30 am on Monday, January 5, 2026 on a first come, first served basis.

To register go to lakegenevacamp.com, click "Family Camp," then "Online Reservation." Pick dates and unit type. Enter the GROUP CODE: "fcreg2026" to see available housing.

A confirmation email will be sent immediately after payment. If housing is not listed on the site, unfortunately, this means it is not available. Guests may add their name to a waitlist for preferred housing, and staff will follow up if it becomes available. If a date change or cancellation is needed, please go through the Firefly guest portal to request. Changes to accommodation may incur a \$35 handling fee. Refunds, minus a \$50 administrative fee, are cheerfully given for cancellations received before June 1. No refunds are given after that date. FULL PAYMENT due by May 31. Reservations made after May 31 require full payment.

DINING HALL

Delicious buffet style meals are served daily in the Dining Hall. Tickets may be purchased in the camp office anytime during Family Camp or with your online registration.

One free meal ticket for each 10 purchased! (10 at the same price point).

Online pre-purchased meal tickets are given at check-in.

Snacks and additional food items are available for purchase on the grounds. Geneva Java is open daily serving specialty coffees, smoothies, snacks, etc. Late evening coffee, tea, juice, and dessert specials are offered in the Dining Hall following the evening services.

No cooking is allowed in any housing unit.

GENERAL GUIDELINES AND POLICIES

NOT PERMITTED AT LGCC: Tobacco of any kind, vaping, THC products, alcohol, illegal drugs, and fireworks. Anyone bringing these items to LGCC will be asked to leave without a refund. No ATVs, battery or motorized recreation scooters/skateboards are allowed. Golf carts may only be used by people with a valid driver's license and over age 16.

ON GROUNDS COOKING/GRILLING: AGAINST FIRE CODE! NO COOKING is allowed inside any Lake Geneva housing units. Outdoor grilling must be away from decks and at least 10 feet from any building. Contact the office if you have any questions about grilling/cooking.

CHILDREN/YOUTH: ALL children and youth under the age of 18 must have adult supervision.

PET POLICY: Apart from qualified service animals individually trained for guests with disabilities, animals or pets are not allowed at LGCC, except in RVs restricted to only the Hillcrest RV Park. Pets must always be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your pet. Emotional support animals are not permitted. A \$200 cleaning fee will be assessed if the pet policy is disregarded.

BEDDING/TOWELS: Personal items such as bedding, towels and pillows are not provided except in hotel-style rooms. LGCC does have bedding sets and towels for rent if needed. Contact the office for rental prices.

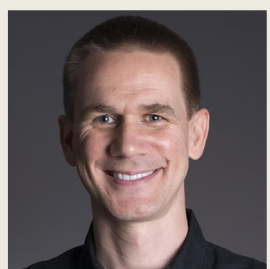
MOTORIZED/NON-MOTORIZED: Skateboards, scooters and bicycles may not be used in any buildings or left on walkways. **All vehicles (including golf carts) please adhere to the camp speed limit of 9mph.** Be polite/respectful to the guests around you when driving. You must be 16+ to drive a golf cart.

INSURANCE: Secondary insurance coverage is carried by LGCC. All injuries must be reported to the camp office and first submitted to the individual camper's insurance holder. A nurse will be available on-site daily.

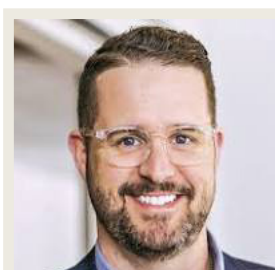

CAMPING TENTS: Tent sites are on a first-come basis in the West 600 block and North Hillcrest RV Park.

****Rustic Cabins**** Only dining tents (NO SLEEPING TENTS) are allowed near Rustic Cabins. All sleeping tents must be placed in the two designated tenting areas.
